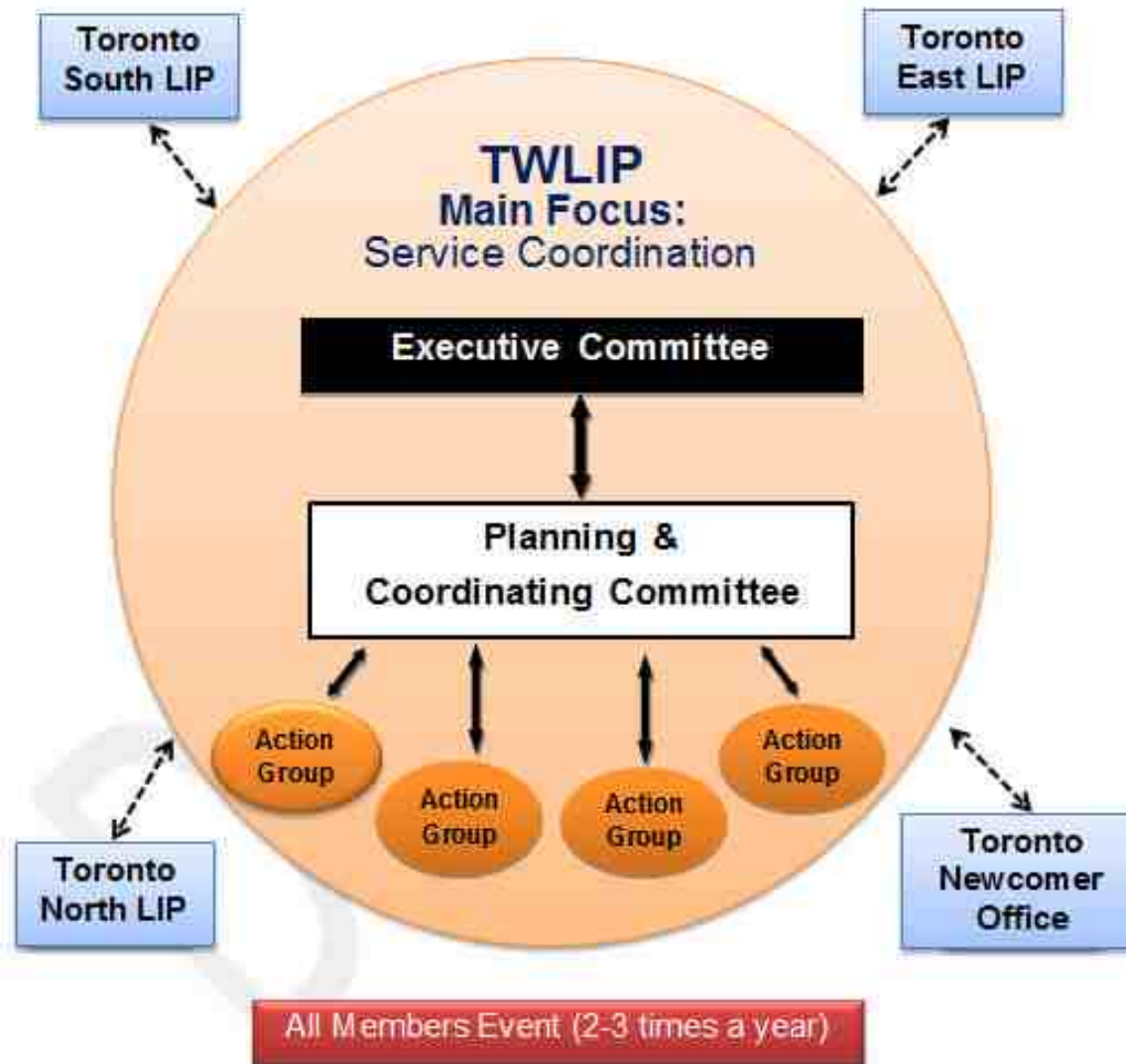


New TWLIP Structure



ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Executive Committee

- ❑ **Oversees** the TWLIP project, monitors progress towards the overall vision and objectives
- ❑ **Advises** members on the development and implementation of a TWLIP Communications Plan and Sustainability Strategy
- ❑ **Reviews** ongoing and annual evaluation results
- ❑ **Eight members** (four partners + four agency members)
- ❑ Must hold a **senior level position** in their organization and be able to make decisions on behalf of their agency

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Planning and Coordinating Committee

- ❑ **Identifies priorities** for action and implementation, with reference to the existing Action Plans and research conducted by LIPs before amalgamation, and in response to shifts and emerging issues within the quadrant
- ❑ Members lead or participate in the implementation of each planned activity to ensure that initiatives are carried out successfully; **identify or appoint** appropriate TWLIP members/ agency staff/ outside resource (as required) to Action Groups which carry out each activity
- ❑ Works with TWLIP staff to **leverage funds** from other sources for project implementation
- ❑ **15-20 members** (Mix to ensure diversity)
- ❑ Members in this group must be able to **appoint staff** from their agency to Action Groups, OR to **commit time** themselves to carry out planned activities

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Action Groups

- ❑ **Develop and implement** projects and initiatives that have been identified by the Planning & Coordinating Committee
- ❑ Meet to work on **identified actions**, with administrative and facilitative support from the TWLIP staff
- ❑ Planning and Coordinating Committee (with staff support) will play a significant role in recruiting appropriate TWLIP members and other community stakeholders to each Action Group
- ❑ The Action Groups are **Goal-oriented and project focused**. The groups will be dissolved/ restructured/ dormant (depending on the next steps) when identified actions are completed and the goals are achieved
