- Internationally educated healthcare professionals with a minimum of 1 year of related work experience, obtained outside of Canada
- Educated at a post-secondary level in a regulated healthcare profession outside of Canada
- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) 8 or higher
- Permanent Residents or Convention Refugees of Canada
- No previous work experience within the Canadian broader healthcare sector
