- Have educational qualifications outside of Canada with a minimum equivalency to a Canadian degree or diploma in computer science or related
- Have previous work experience outside of Canada in information technology, computer programming or related
- · Have a current Canadian Language Benchmark Assessment at a minimum Level 7/8
